Three Routes

All of the routes start at Foothill College in Los Altos Hills and wind through redwoods and mountains toward the coast and back.

The half century (56 miles, 8:30-10 am start) climbs to Saratoga Gap, descends Alpine Road to La Honda, and returns through Sky Londa.

The metric century (71 miles, 7:30-9 am start) continues to San Gregorio, climbs Tunitas Creek Road, descends Kings Mountain to Woodside, and returns.

The century (113 miles, 6-7:30 am start) continues to Pescadero and Pigeon Point before heading to Tunitas Creek Road, and also adds a loop to Half Moon Bay.

Logistics

Route sheets and rider numbers may be picked up between noon and 4 pm, Saturday, May 31, at The Bicycle Outfitters, 963 Fremont Avenue, Los Altos (off Foothill Expressway near Miramonte/Loyola Drive) or at the start at Foothill College on Sunday morning.

We encourage slower riders to arrive 30 minutes prior to the start time for their route so that they can leave when the route opens to insure proper support during their ride. Do not start too early or you may get to the rest stops before the food!

A hot meal will be served at Foothill College at the end of the ride.

Directions to the Start

From I-280, take the El Monte Road Exit west. Turn right at Foothill College and bear right on the Perimeter Road. Follow signs to Lot 3.
