The tours begin at Foothill College in Los Altos Hills, on El Monte Road at Interstate 280. Foothill has easy access and ample parking. Lockers and shower facilities will be available all day. Bring your towel and lock.

Parking directions will be given as you arrive. You must park in designated parking or possibly be ticketed. Prior to checking in, go to the bike inspection area located near the stadium.



Tour Support provided to all participants includes a detailed route sheet, road direction arrows, rider tags, radio dispatched SAG support, and a '92 patch.

This year's menu. Start the ride with a bagel and a PowerBar. Morning rest stops offer liquids, a variety of muffins, fruit & nut bars, and lots of fresh fruit. TOUR ROUTES

All rides are **very hilly** and, except for the 50 km, strenuous. Be in shape for lengthy climbs, and be cautious while you enjoy the long descents. Riders biking to Skyline, the Santa Cruz mountains and the coast should carry warm clothing.

200K- Registration open 6:00-7:30 am

An incredibly scenic ride to the Pacific and back, our route to Highway 1 is up Kings Mountain, past the forests of Memorial Park and south along the coastline. Climb Bonny Doon and continue to Felton for lunch and the final ascent on East Zayante to breathtaking views from Skyline Ridge. Total altitude gain is more than 9300 feet making this a very challenging ride.

100M - Registration open 6:00-7:30 am

This 100 mile course is no less demanding than the 200K. From Old La Honda journey south to Saratoga Gap. The route then winds through the redwoods of Big Basin. Riders will ascend Jamison Creek and, after lunch, East Zayante, to enjoy panoramic vistas of the Santa Cruz Mountains. Over 9700 feet of climb makes this one of the toughest 100 miles you'll ride this year.

100K- Registration open 7:30-9:00 am

The 100K is a lovely tour through La Honda to the ocean. Follow the 100 milers up to Skyline, then join the 200K route to Pescadero. Have lunch on the beach at San Gregorio, and return via Skylonda and the Portola Valley loop. Total elevation gain for this ride is 5000 feet.

50K - Registration open 9:00 -10:00 am

Travel the foothills of Portola Valley to the town of Woodside. Enjoy a leisurely pace through Atherton and the beautiful Stanford campus. Lunch at a shaded Palo Alto park offers a pleasant respite before the return trip to Foothill College on the bike paths of Los Altos and Los Altos Hills.

TOUR RULES

• ALL RIDERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR ANSI OR SNELL APPROVED HELMETS..... NO HELMET - NO RIDE!

- Bicycle inspection is available on a voluntary basis.
- Riders should carry a spare tube, pump, tools, water bottle, phone money, and medical identification.
- Riders under 18 years of age must have a parent or guardian present during registration in order for them to sign a medical authorization form and release agreement. Children under 14 years must ride with an adult.
- Any rider who abandons the ride must notify ride headquarters at Foothill College. Phone numbers will be on route sheets.
- The Sequoia Century is a tour, not a race. Please be courteous to other cyclists and motorists.
- Riders must obey all California Vehicle Code Laws. Those who don't may be cited and/or removed from the ride. Participants will be required to wear rider tags for SAG control, law enforcement, and safety.
- During registration, each rider will be required to sign a Release Agreement with Western Wheelers and sign a California Vehicle Code Safety Agreement.
