## <u>Sequoia</u> Century

The fifth annual Sequoia Century will include three bicycle tours, of 100, 50, and 25 miles, through some of the most scenic parts of the San Francisco Peninsula. The route goes from Palo Alto to San Gregorio on the coast, to Pescadero, Skylonda and up Skyline to Saratoga Gap. After a long descent down Highway 9, the route winds through the foothills back to Palo Alto.

WHEN IS IT? Sunday, June 11. Riders on the 100-mile tour can start between 5:30 a.m. and 8 a.m. Those riding 25 or 50 miles can start between 5:30 a.m. and 10 a.m.

COST: \$5 for the 100-mile and 50-mile rides, if payment is received by June 4, \$7 after that. \$3 for the 25-mile ride, regard-less of when the payment is received. The cost includes lunch, complete sag wagon service, snacks and drinks at checkpoints, and a patch for those who complete the tours.

STARTING Gunn High School, 780 Arastradero Road, Palo Alto. From
POINT: Highway 101, take the Oregon Expressway and turn left on
Foothill Expressway, and then turn left on Arastradero. From
Interstate 280, take Page Mill Road toward Palo Alto and turn
right on Foothill, then turn left on Arastradero.

SAFETY: All bicycles will be inspected to insure that brakes and other equipment are working properly. Helmets are recommended for all riders.

AGE LIMITS: Entrants under 18 must submit a completed release form (see application form) signed by a parent or legal guardian. Riders under 14 must be accompanied on the ride by a parent or legal guardian.

WHAT TO Spare tire or tube, patch kit, water bottle, pump, and BRING: minor tools. The sag wagons also will carry some tools and spare parts.
